On Saturday, Sept. 3, the second edition of Paddle Brome Lake took place, organized by Renaissance Brome Lake (RBL). Forty paddle board, kayak and canoe enthusiasts including 10 adaptive-sport athletes participated in the event by paddling part or all of the 19 km course along the shores of Brome Lake. "Paddle Brome Lake allows paddlers to have a good time with family and friends, do physical activity and admire nature and the shores of our lake," says Don Joyce, administrator of RBL.

What a day, what a journey

On this beautiful sunny day, the paddlers gathered at Douglass Beach set out early in the morning to tackle

the journey on the lake. They traveled the lake counter-clockwise and here and there, welcomed new paddlers enthusiastic about the idea of joining the pack. Four hours and 19 km later, the paddlers were greeted back at the beach by RBL organizers who were waiting for them with a refreshing snack.

The first edition in 2021

For the very first edition of the event, in September 2021, 35 paddlers joined RBL. Given this success, the organization decided to make "Paddle Brome Lake" its annual "signature" event: an event that will now return every September. Good news for paddle sport enthusiasts!
